DECISION EXPECTED ON YEE APPEAL TOMORROW

MIAMI – U.S. Army General James T. Hill, Commander, United States Southern Command is expected to announce a decision on the appeal of Article 15 proceedings submitted to him by Chaplain James J. Yee during a 4 p.m. press conference here Wednesday.

On March 22nd, Yee was found guilty of adultery and pornography charges and issued a written reprimand for his misconduct by U.S. Army Maj. Gen. Geoffrey D. Miller, then the Commander of Joint Task Force-Guantanamo.

Shortly after those proceedings, Yee appealed his case to Hill, who oversees military operations at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.
