



Getting here is *easy*.



BY METRORAIL

Get off at the Government Center Station in beautiful Downtown Miami, walk south across NW First Street and go up the stairs on the north side of the cultural center, or use the ramp on the south side. The entrance to the museum is in the plaza.

BY CAR

If **traveling NORTHBOUND**, on **I-95**, take the NW 2nd Street exit (**Exit 4**). Go right on NW 2nd Street, then right on NW 2nd Avenue for one block. The Cultural Center is on the left and its parking garage is on the right.

If **traveling SOUTHBOUND** on **I-95**, exit at Orange Bowl/NW 8th street (**Exit 5A**). At the 5th traffic light, turn left onto NW 2nd Street. Then turn right onto NW 2nd Avenue. The Cultural Center is on the left and its parking garage on the right.

PARKING

Discounted, covered parking is available at the Miami-Dade Cultural Center parking garage. Take the over the street walkway from parking level 2 on the south side directly to the Plaza. Be sure to get your parking ticket validated by our lobby cashier.


Experience the sights, sounds and drama of 10,000 years of South Florida history through the museum's hallmark exhibition, *Tropical Dreams*.

The museum's special exhibitions create a dynamic look to our past. Changing every few months, the shows are most often culled from our own collections and research in southern Florida and the Caribbean.





The museum has many exciting, hands-on activities and programs for children. Our Research Center has an amazing collection of books and photos waiting for you to enjoy.


Whole families can take in Miami on a Historic Tour, including walking, boating, bicycling, metrorail and bus tours, given by popular
