United States Government (USG) personnel (military, civilian and contractors) seeking to enter the USSOUTHCOM Area of Responsibility (AOR) must refer to SC Regulation 40-501 and respective attachments to determine if minimum medical entry requirements are met. If a medical waiver is needed, SC Regulation 40-501 will walk you through the process. Once the waiver packet is complete, please contact the appropriate USSOUTHCOM component surgeon below for adjudication.
