National Hurricane Center Description: **MY PLAN for Hurricane threat of this category:**

CAT 1	74-95 mph	64-82 kt	Very dangerous winds will produce some damage	Evac Y N ; Home or Enter Address
CAT 2	96-110 mph	83-95 kt	Extremely dangerous winds will cause extensive damage	Evac Y N ; Home or Enter Address
CAT 3 (major)	111-129 mph	96-112 kt	Devastating damage will occur	Evac Y N ; Enter Address; Out of area contact
CAT 4 (major)	130-156 mph	113-136 kt	Catastrophic damage will occur	Evac Y N ; Enter Address; Out of area contact
CAT 5 (major)	157 mph or higher	137 kt or higher	Catastrophic damage will occur. Most of the area will be uninhabitable for weeks or months.	Evac Y N ; Enter Address; Out of area contact

MILITARY HURCON SYSTEM	
HURCON 5 (H5): 01 June to 30 Nov (Hurricane Season) No active storm	SEPARATES AND NAMES TIME PERIODS BEFORE, DURING AND POST STORM HURCON 1-E (H1-E): Sustained 50-knot (58 mph) winds or greater are occurring and other dangerous condition associated with the storm are present. NO OUTSIDE ACTIVITY. HURCON 1E H1E Sustained 50knot 58 mph winds or greater are occurring and other dangerous condition associated with the storm are present NO OUTSIDE ACTIVITY HURCON 1-R (H1-R): When winds in excess of 35 knots (40 mph) have subsided for a sustained period of two hours or more. Life-threatening storm hazards have passed but damage may persist and only emergency responders and damage assessment personnel are released to move about.
HURCON 4 (H4): HURCON 4 is declared when winds in excess of 50 knots/58mph are possible within 96 hours.	
HURCON 3 (H3): HURCON 3 is declared when winds in excess of 50 knots/58mph are possible within 72 hours.	
HURCON 2 (H2): HURCON 2 is declared when winds in excess of 50 knots/58mph are possible within 48 hours.	
HURCON 1 (H1): HURCON 1 is declared when winds in excess of 50 knots/58mph are possible within 24 hours.
