

Accessing NIPR SOUTHCOM Virtual Desktop From your Personal Computer

SOUTHCOM users can now access their *NIPR* Virtual Desktop (Same as HQ NIPR) using any computer (Windows and MAC) from any location with a commercial internet connection via the VMware Horizon Client and a Department of Defense Common Access Card (CAC) and CAC Reader.

<u>Users</u> can pick up a CAC reader at your local service desk (if you don't already have one). Remember you can still use 'Ohome' as your alternative. (www.office.com)

Initial Setup

You will need a CAC reader.

Insert your CAC into the CAC reader connected to your computer.

Install the DoD Root Certificates https://public.cyber.mil/pkipke/end-users/getting-started for instructions.

STEP 1

Enter the following URL in your web browser: https://vdi.ent.southcom.mil

Ensure you select your "Authentication Certificate"



STEP 2

Select "Install VMware Horizon Client"_____



STEP 3

In the Download VMware Horizon Clients Portal, **select** the "**Go to Downloads**" link applicable to your operating environment to download installer and select **Download Now**.

Run the installer and follow the prompts to install the client.

Security Limitations

 Downloading and Uploading files, including email attachments, from your Virtual Desktop environment to your personal computer is not authorized.

STEP 4

Once installation is complete, **double-click** the VMware Horizon Client shortcut on your desktop.



STEP 6

Enter your PIN and Login when prompted to Authenticate. **Accept** DoD Consent Banner.
