**What to Bring to Obtain a Florida Driver License or Identification Card:**

1. **Proof of Identification (An Original of One):** U.S. Birth Certificate; Valid U.S. Passport or passport card; Consular Report of Birth Abroad; Certificate of Naturalization, form N-550 or N-570
2. **For Name Changes:** Marriage Licenses or Divorce Decree or Court Order
3. **Proof of Social Security Number (An Original of One):** Social Security Card; SSA-1099; Pay Stub/Check; W-2.
4. **Two (2) Proofs of Resident Address:** Must provide one (1) household information document with the residential address in the name of the certifier: Deed, Mortgage Agreement, Recent Monthly Mortgage Statement, or Rental/Lease Agreement. **AND** Must provide one (1) supporting document with the residential address in the name of the certifier: FL Voters Registration Card; JKV Maintenance Statement; Phone Bill; Correspondence from financial institution including checking, savings, or investment statements. Mail from federal, state, county, or city government agency. Credit Card Statement; Automobile/Renters Insurance policy or bill.
