WHAT IS COVID-19?

Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a respiratory virus that was first identified in December 2019 in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China. This virus probably originally emerged from an animal source but is now spreading from person-to-person.

United States Southern Command is closely monitoring the situation and taking the necessary steps to keep all personnel safe.

HOW IS IT TRANSMITTED?



Close personal contact, shaking hands



Droplets while coughing and sneezing



Touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF TESTING?

The COVID-19 trailer, located behind the outdoor gym, is open Monday through Friday from 0730-1200; 1300-1430. For antibody testing, contact your healthcare provider.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR CARE?

Beneficiaries 18 years and older; workplace exposure to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

HOW DO I PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19?



Wash your hands with soap and water often for at least 20 seconds.



Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.



Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?

Current symptoms reported have included respiratory illness with fever, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, headache, muscle aches, and chills.


I have traveled within the last two weeks.
